

BUTLER COUNTY GENERAL AUTHORITY

A seven member Butler County General Authority (Authority) was established by the Butler County Commissioners on June 22, 2001, under the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act, of May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as amended. The governing Board of the Authority is appointed by the Butler County Commissioners. The Authority was organized and exists for the public purpose of financing working capital, acquiring, holding, constructing, financing, improving, maintaining, operating, owning, or leasing projects that benefit municipalities or school districts. However, the Authority is limited in that it shall not participate in or compete with any commercial or industrial entities, sewer or water authorities, garbage collection enterprises, or those entities, municipal or private, that provide services within the County of Butler.
