# Agency Services and Programs


## WHO ARE WE?

The Butler County Area Agency on Aging was established July 1, 1984 as a unit of the County government, and governed by the County Board of Commissioners.

The Area Agency on Aging works with a volunteer Advisory Board, who advises Agency leaders on matters relating to the development and administration of the Agency. Funding for services is provided by the Federal Older American's Act; the PA Department of Aging Grant #4100034708; the PA Lottery; Medical Assistance; the Butler County General Fund; donations; and service fees.

## WHAT DO WE DO?

The mission of the Area Agency on Aging is to provide support to Butler County residents, age 60 years and older, (and their families), and to help seniors remain independent in the most appropriate setting; ideally, their own homes. Support from the Agency may be in the form of service, or information. Some services and programs are provided directly by the Agency, while other services are subcontracted with various community agencies.
