

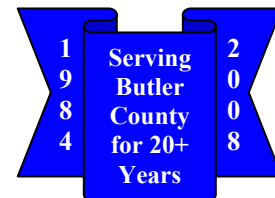

Senior Health Fair

This event is held annually in May, in celebration of Older Americans Month. BCAAoA, local participants and providers combine their efforts to make this event successful and informative for the senior consumers of Butler County. In addition to this event, we participate in other local health fairs, sponsored by state representatives, universities, churches, and local businesses.
