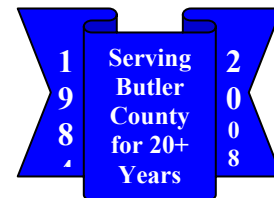

## Butler County Senior Transportation Options

### BART (Butler Area & Rural Transit)

This is a shared ride system transporting 60+ seniors to senior centers, medical appointments, adult day care, and other destinations within Butler County, using lift vans. BART is available Monday through Friday from 7am – 5pm. Shared ride means that it is a bus with other people – like traditional public transportation – but you schedule your ride around your appointment – like traditional taxi service.

Reservations can be made up to two weeks in advance or as late as the morning of the day before the desired trip. Advanced scheduling is highly recommended. Please schedule early by calling **724-282-6060**. To register or to get more information, please call Audrey, at **724-282-1904**.

### AIRE RIDE

Provides transportation to **out of county medical appointments** for seniors 60 years or older. Residents must live in Butler City **or** south of Butler City. Aire Ride trips are scheduled for Tuesday appointments only. The actual medical appointment time needs to be between 10:00 and 2:00.

Trip requests should be made two weeks in advance calling the Area Agency on Aging office at **724-282-3008 or 1-888-367-2434**. Riders must be pre-registered to participate and calling the Area Agency on Aging at the above numbers can do this.

**THE AREA AGENCY ON AGING** utilizes volunteer drivers to transport seniors over the age of 60 to **medical appointments** in and out of Butler County through the Medical Transportation Service. This service is limited due to the number and schedule of volunteers.

Riders must register and trip requests must be made two weeks in advance by calling the Aging Office at **724-282-3008** or **1-888-367-2434**.

**“THE BUS”** (The Butler Township City-Joint Municipal Transit Authority) provides free rides for individuals over the age of 65, Monday through Saturday.

Routes include Butler City, Butler Township, Clearview Mall, and Butler County Community College. Seniors over the age of 65 must have a Senior Pass to ride free.

Proof of age is required to qualify for the Senior Pass. Passes and schedules are available at the terminal at: 113 E Cunningham Street, in Butler. If you have never ridden “The Bus” before, they have staff that will ride with you the first time. Call **724-283-0445** for more information.

**BUTLER BLIND ASSOCIATION** will assist visually impaired individuals with transportation to **vision appointments**. The Blind Association can be reached by calling **724-287-4059**.

---

**St. Vincent DePaul**, may provide one way bus passes **for emergencies only** to the Pittsburgh bus station. Call **724-287-3994** or **724-482-4005** for more information.

---

**Disabled American Veterans** will assist - **as a last resort only** - to provide transportation to an appointment at the Butler VA Medical Center. The shuttle can also transport to the Pittsburgh VA. Call **724-477-5010** at least 1-2 weeks in advance for details.

---

**The Butler Assist Coach** is a wheelchair accessible van that is available on a private pay basis to transport individuals on **medically related trips** (such as: doctor appointments, transferring from hospital to home or a nursing facility, etc.). Call 724-283-4385 for more information.
