

Escort Drivers

Volunteers drive ambulatory Senior Consumers to medical appointments. Escort drivers volunteer as their schedule permits. A county vehicle is available to escort volunteers or mileage is reimbursed.

Phone Reassurance

Volunteers place 5-15 minute phone calls to an isolated senior on a designated day and time, to ensure their safety and provide socialization.

Friendly Visitor

Volunteers visit homebound senior consumers who are isolated from socialization. The one-hour weekly visits provide some companionship for an otherwise lonely person. Mileage is reimbursed.



Health Insurance Counseling

APPRISE volunteers are trained to provide free, objective advice and help to older adults in the areas of Medicare, Medigap insurance, Medicare HMO'S, Medical Assistance, PACE, and long term care insurance.

Volunteer Ombudsman

Volunteers represent the ombudsman program by visiting local nursing homes and personal care facilities. The purpose is to provide assurance in the form of information and education regarding resident rights as well as to socialize with residents. The AAoA Ombudsman staff will provide training and supervision.

Newsletter Mailings

Every month, 6000 newsletters are mailed or distributed throughout the County of Butler. Volunteers place mailing labels on the newsletters that are pre-folded for mailing. This is a great activity to keep your hands busy while socializing with other volunteers.



Senior Center Program Volunteers

Volunteers at the Senior Centers share their talents and passions by conducting activities like line dancing, computer training, crafts and exercise (like our *Prime-time Program*) at one of the eleven senior community centers in the County of Butler.
