ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF COURT


AND NOW, to wit, this 28th day of March 2002, by the Court's own motion, it is hereby ordered and decreed that any person certified by Neighborhood Legal Services Association (NLSA) to be financially eligible under Legal Services Corporation regulations and to otherwise qualify for representation under NLSA's Reduced Fee (pro bono) Custody Referral Program; Pro Bono Custody Referral Program; Custody Conflict Referral Program; custody raised through the Reduced Fee Divorce Referral Program, or representation in custody by NLSA, is granted to proceed in forma pauperis waiving the Custody Conciliator's fee for custody conferences before the Court of Common Pleas of Butler County, Pennsylvania; and that all Prothonotary and Sheriff's fees in such proceedings are to be charged to the County of Butler.

Any individual who has been granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis in custody proceedings as related to this Order of Court, and who has a substantial change in their financial situation at any time during the course of said custody action, shall be required to inform the Court of Common Pleas of Butler County, Pennsylvania so that said court can decide if said individual shall be required to pay any waived court costs or conciliator fees relating to the custody action.

This Order is to be applicable to indigent persons who are instituting custody proceedings or defending custody actions.


The Prothonotary and the Sheriff are hereby directed to charge all such fees to the County of Butler for any party who presents a Certification of Eligibility from Neighborhood Legal Services Association.


AND NOW, to wit, this 28th day of March 2002, by the Court's own motion, it is hereby ordered and decreed that any person certified by Neighborhood Legal Services Association (NLSA) to be financially eligible under Legal Services Corporation regulations and to otherwise qualify for representation under NLSA's Reduced Fee Divorce Referral Program, is granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis in divorce proceedings before the Court of Common Pleas of Butler County, Pennsylvania, and that all Prothonotary and Sheriff's fees in such proceedings are to be charged to the County of Butler.

Any individual who has been granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis in divorce proceedings as related to this Order of Court, and who has a substantial change in their financial situation at any time during the course of said divorce action, shall be required to inform the Court of Common Pleas of Butler County, Pennsylvania so that said court can decide if said individual shall be required to pay any waived court costs or conciliator fees relating to the divorce action.

This Order is to be applicable to indigent persons who are instituting divorce proceedings, defending divorce actions or filing counterclaims in a divorce action filed against them.

The Prothonotary and the Sheriff are hereby directed to charge all such fees to the County of Butler for any party who presents a Certification of Eligibility from Neighborhood Legal Services Association.






AND NOW comes Pamela Lynn Dalton-Arlotti, Esquire, Chairman of the Public

Service Committee of the Butler County Bar Association, and moves this Honorable Court to:

- a) allow any attorney providing pro bono or reduced fee representation in a custody action to an indigent person referred by Neighborhood Legal Services Association, to enter a limited appearance in said custody action with regard to an Application for Special Relief, a Conciliation Conference, or a Conference, upon filing with the Prothonotary a Praecipe for Entry of Limited Appearance;
- b) require that any Entry of Limited Appearance specifically delineate the specific proceeding for which the attorney is entering an appearance;
- c) require that each Entry of Limited Appearance specify to whom notices regarding the proceedings should be sent, and further specify whether the entering attorney wants to receive notices only on the subject matter for which they are entering their appearance or notices regarding all custody proceedings in the case;
- d) require that the Praecipe for Entry of Limited Appearance indicate that upon completion of the services described within the entry of appearance, the pro-bono or reduced fee attorney may withdraw from the case;

e) require that any attorney withdraw from the action upon which they are appearing by presenting to the Court a Praecipe for Withdrawal of Limited Appearance with an attached Notice of Presentment sent to all parties and counsel of record, as well as a Proposed Order of Court approving the withdrawal.

- b) that each Entry of Limited Appearance must specifically delineate the specific proceeding for which the attorney is entering an appearance;
- c) that each Entry of Limited Appearance must specify to whom notices regarding the proceedings should be sent, and further specify whether the entering attorney wants to receive notices only on the subject matter for which they are entering their appearance or notices regarding all custody proceedings in the case;
- d) that each Praecipe for Entry of Limited Appearance must indicate that upon completion of the services described within the limited entry of appearance, the pro-bono or reduced fee attorney may withdraw from the case;
- e) that each attorney so entering their appearance must withdraw from the action upon which they are appearing by presenting to the Court a Praecipe for Withdrawal of Limited Appearance


