

Treatment Assessment & Referral Services

■ Initial Screening:

- Completed during first phone or office contact
- An assessment will be scheduled at this time

■ Assessment: 1-hour, face-to-face contact Monday – Friday in the Butler County D&A Office

- Assessments determine –
 - Whether or not there is a need for treatment
 - An appropriate level of care
 - Selection of provider
 - Length of stay
 - Referral to treatment, if necessary
 - Information and referral to other (non-drug & alcohol) needed services
- Referrals may be made to all levels of care including:
 - Outpatient
 - Intensive outpatient
 - Partial Hospitalization
 - Residential Services

■ Funding Eligibility:

- Funding eligibility is determined by case manager upon completion of eligibility verification before treatment referral is finalized.

- * **Clients are expected to provide the following documentation at the time of their assessment:**
 - **Income Verification**
 - **Proof that they have applied for medical assistance at the Butler County Assistance Office**

■ **Additional Services Available:**

- Case management services provide clients with other ancillary contacts necessary to pursue a drug-free lifestyle. These services include, but are not limited to, providing clients assistance with:
 - Housing
 - Employment
 - Transportation
 - Referrals to educational/vocational resources
 - Referrals to the County Assistance Office
 - Referrals to mental and/or physical health services
